

Arkadiusz Jawien MD, PhD

Professor Arkadiusz Jawien MD, PhD – Chairman of the Department of Vascular Surgery and Angiology, University Hospital No.1, Collegium Medicum, Nicolaus Copernicus University, Bydgoszcz, Poland.

He is a graduate of the Academy of Medicine in Poznan, Poland. His surgical training was conducted in several international institutions e.g. Catholic University of Leuven (Belgium), University of Lund (Sweden), l'Hopital Salpetiere-Pitie in Paris (France). In 1988 he obtained a PhD by Academy of Medicine in Bydgoszcz, Poland. Professor Arkadiusz Jawien had also post-doctoral position in Department of Surgery, University of Washington in Seattle (1988-1991), where he was involved in vascular biology research.

He held several positions e.g. President of Polish Society for Vascular Surgery (2018-2020), President of World Federation of Vascular Societies (2017), President of European Society for Vascular Surgery (2014/2015), Secretary General of International Union of Angiology (2010-2012), President of European Venous Forum (2003/2004). Professor Arkadiusz Jawien was an Editor of Acta Angiologica and currently is an Editor of Polish Journal of Wound Management (Leczenie Ran)

His clinical interest include, among others, endovascular aortic aneurysm repair, peripheral arterial reconstructions, chronic venous disease diagnosis and treatment including endovenous thrombolysis and stenting and venous leg ulcer management. He is the author or coauthor of more than 600 papers published in English or Polish.
