Henrik Sillesen was Head of dept. and Professor of vascular surgery, Dept. of Vascular Surgery, Rigshospitalet, Univ. of Copenhagen, Denmark, from 1998-2021.

From 2021 and currently, Medical Director of the Novo Nordisk Foundation.

Appointed Professor of Vascular Surgery, Univ. of Copenhagen 2012.

He has authored 253 peer-review, published papers (pubmed) and given > 250 invited lectures at international meetings in 34 countries. H-index is 45 and > 12.000 citations (Web of Science).

Henrik Sillesen has supervised 14 doctoral thesis (DMSc) or PhD degrees of which 11 are in vascular surgery. Official opponent for a total of 12 thesis; 6 for doctorates in medical science and 6 for the PhD degree: 3 international (Holland, Sweden and Finland) and 9 in Denmark.

Henrik Sillesen has served on the editorial board of Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology and Eur J Vasc Endovasc Surg and has been Guest Editor Journal of American College Cardiology.

Henrik Sillesen has authored guidelines for Euro Society for Vascular Surgery, World Federation of Vascular Specialties, European Society of Cardiology and American Society for Echocardiography.

President for the **THE EUROPEAN SOCIETY OF VASCULAR SURGERY** 2018-19 and he served as Secretary General 2004-9, as President for **WORLD FEDERATION FOR VASCULAR SPECIALTIES** in 2009 and Secretary General for **SCANDINAVIAN ASSOCIATION OF VASCULAR SURGERY** 1999-2004.

President for the **DANISH SOCIETY FOR VASCULAR SURGERY** 2003-2005 and President for the **DANISH HEART FOUNDATION** in 2004-2008.
