Hiroshi Shigematsu, M.D, PhD, is the Executive Director of Vascular Surgery at Sanno Medical Center and Professor of the Clinical Research Center for Medicine at the International University of Health & Welfare, Tokyo, Japan. Dr. Shigematsu graduated with a Medical Degree from the University of Tokyo and completed his residency in General Surgery at Tokyo University Hospital. There he was a Professor of Surgery, Chief of the Division of Vascular Surgery, Director of the Surgical Center and also served as a Director of Central Facility. He is the Emeritus President of both the Japanese Society for Cardiovascular Surgery and Japanese Society for Phlebology, the President (Director) and the Executive Board Member of Japanese College of Angiology. The Past President and an Executive Board Member of the Japanese Society for Vascular Surgery and Japanese Society for Endovascular Intervention. Internationally, Dr. Shigematsu was the Past President of the Asian Society for Vascular Surgery, World Federation of Vascular Societies and a Vice President of the International Union of Angiology. He is a member of many societies including the Japanese Surgical Society, Japanese Society of Gastroenterology, Japanese Society of Gastroenterological Surgery, Japan Surgical Association, Japanese Society for Gerontology, Japanese Society for Microcirculation, Japanese Society for Atherosclerosis, Society for Vascular Surgery (USA), a Scientific Committee Member of the International College of Angiology, European Society for Vascular and Endovascular Surgery, International Union of Phlebology and a Board Member of Japan-China Medical Communication Center. He is an Editor of the International Angiology, Annals of Vascular Disease, Journals of Japanese College of Angiology, Japanese Society for Vascular Surgery, Japanese Society for Phlebology and Thrombosis and Circulation (Japanese). Has more than 900 papers including 130 published in the English Journals.
