

PETER GLOVICZKI, MD, FACS.

Peter Gloviczki, MD, FACS, is Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Vascular Surgery (JVS) Publications. He is the Joe M. and Ruth Roberts Emeritus Professor of Surgery, served as Chair, Division of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery (2000-2010) and Director of Gonda Vascular Center (2002-2010) at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN, United States. Dr Gloviczki received his Medical Degree at Semmelweis University with honors (Sub Auspiciis Rei Publicae Popularis) in Hungary, trained at Városmajor Cardiovascular Clinic in Budapest, at St. Michel and St. Joseph hospitals in Paris, France and at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. He joined the staff of Mayo Clinic in 1987. His clinical practice included all areas of vascular surgery: arterial, venous and lymphatic. He has special interest in venous reconstructions and endoscopic vein surgery, in vascular malformations, and in lymphatic and chylous disorders. At Mayo Clinic he performed over 10,000 operations. He is President of the Frank J. Veith International Society and Past President of Society for Vascular Surgery, World Federation of Vascular Societies, American Venous Forum, International Union of Angiology, Society for Clinical Vascular Surgery, among others. He is member of the American Surgical Association, Distinguished Fellow of the SVS, AVF, Honorary Member of 20 national and international societies. He is Advisory Professor of the Jiao Tong University School of Medicine in Shanghai, China. The National Library of Medicine lists his 476 peer-reviewed publications, he wrote over 250 book-chapters and editorials, edited eight textbooks, including four Editions of the Handbook of Venous and Lymphatic Disorders, translated to Chinese and Polish. He gave >700 presentations, has 24,498 citations (h-index: 85, Scopus). The University of Washington, Seattle, established the Peter Gloviczki Professorship in Venous and Lymphatic Disorders. His Alma Mater awarded him the “Doctor Honoris Causa” degree and the “Semmelweis “Budapest” Award. He serves on the Board of Trustees of the Semmelweis University. Dr Gloviczki received the Officer’s Cross of the Order of Merit of the Republic of Hungary. His biography “Magic and Medicine” was recently published by Semmelweis University. Dr Gloviczki lives with his wife, Monika Gloviczki, MD, PhD in Scottsdale, Arizona.
